Transaction Codes – History Screen

The Transaction History screen displays either a two (2) or four (4) character transaction code for each transaction. The meaning of the transaction code is determined by dividing it into two parts, the first two (2) characters and the last two (2) characters. The meaning of each of these codes is as follows:

The first part of the transaction code indicates the type of transaction that was performed. The second part of the transaction code indicates either the source or destination of funds relative to the type of transaction.

For example: If you have removed cash from your account, the code would be SWCO (share withdrawal/cash out). Or you could identify a deposited check by the code SDCR (share deposit/check received).
